Motivate your internal junior staff!

Study tour 2007 for trainees and young skilled workers with foundry specific education

The international commission No. 1 „vocational training“ of C.A.E.F. organizes a study tour to Sweden on May 20 to 25, 2007 with visits of 7 foundries and the Technical University in Jönköping. In addition some cultural events will be offered.

The study tour offers a good opportunity

- to motivate your competent junior staff by selecting them for this tour,
- to pay tribute to their performance and
- to promote the foundry specific vocational training.

The study tour aims at

- the professional education of trainees and young skilled workers in the final part of their training or already having finished it (maximum age 25 years).
- the personal contact and exchange of views with young professional colleagues from other countries.

The costs are calculated with approx. 750 €/person, including 5 days of touring, services of driver/courier and tour escort throughout the trip, 5 nights accommodation in double rooms, breakfast, lunch and dinner daily, all admissions and entrance fees, baggage handling throughout the tour and all service charges and value tax.

Not included are the cost for the journey to Sweden by plane or train.

The total price for the study might be changed slightly, because the number of participants is not fixed yet.

The German delegation will be accompanied by an attendant of the VDG.
